Please be advised that, as part of the NJ Turnpike Interchange 6 to 9 Widening Program, a new traffic pattern for State Route 133 eastbound will be put into place starting on or about Friday, January 27, 2012. Traffic will be shifted slightly to the East starting at mileposts 0.0 to 0.6 while maintaining all lanes open to traffic. This traffic pattern will be in place for approximately 4 months.
