Section 6 - Notice of Local Road Closure and Detour

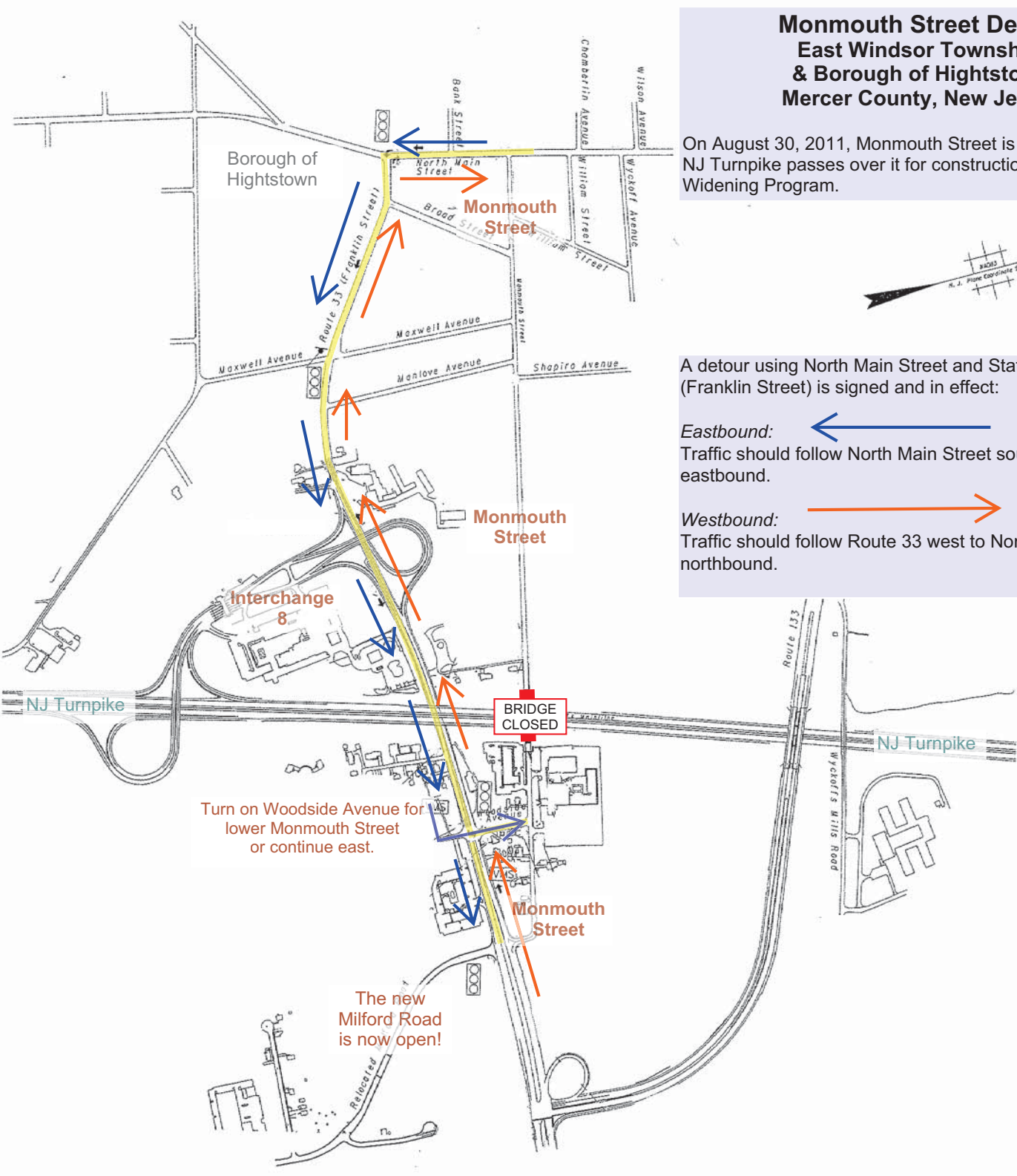


Effective August 30, 2011, **Monmouth Street** at the NJ Turnpike, Townships of East Windsor & Hightstown, Mercer County, **is closed** for construction of a new bridge. A detour using North Main Street and Route 33 will be in place. Please see Detour Map for more details.

Long-Term Traffic Shift in Township of East Windsor, Mercer County: Effective on or about **Jan. 27, 2012**, on **State Route 133 from Mileposts 0.0 - 0.6**, traffic will be shifted to the East while maintaining all lanes of traffic. This Traffic Shift will be in effect for 4 months.

**Monmouth Street Detour
 East Windsor Township
 & Borough of Hightstown
 Mercer County, New Jersey**

On August 30, 2011, Monmouth Street is closed where the NJ Turnpike passes over it for construction of lanes for the Widening Program.

A detour using North Main Street and State Route 33 (Franklin Street) is signed and in effect:

Eastbound: ←
 Traffic should follow North Main Street south to Route 33 eastbound.

Westbound: →
 Traffic should follow Route 33 west to North Main Street northbound.

Turn on Woodside Avenue for lower Monmouth Street or continue east.
